The analysis estimates economic contributions related to dealerships, corporate management locations, and accounts for activities that support operations in other states.

VW's operations supported \$1,121.7 million of economic output in the state directly and through related indirect and induced economic activity.

VW's largest suppliers in Texas are: Delphi Corporation; Interstate Battery System; CEVA Logistics, LLC; Turning Basin Service, Inc

In addition to results shown in Table 2, VW's capital investment generated 1 total jobs in Texas in 2015.

VW's impacts in Texas include not only the company's direct dealership and corporate operations, but also the indirect and induced impacts related to VW's suppliers and sales to employees living in the state. 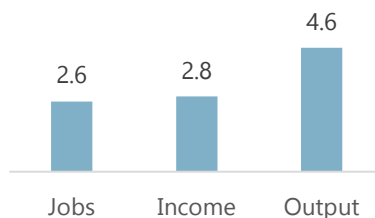

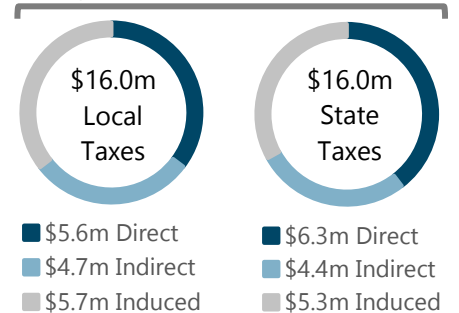
